1. Go to <http://www.azgu.gov/>
2. Select ERMA
3. Select "login" at the top of the left side.
4. Under the heading "welcome to ERMA select first time user option
5. Fill in the appropriate information
6. You will be given EIN #, save that for future reference. It will be your user name for registration
7. A password will be sent to the e-mail that you provided.
8. Upon receiving the e-mail return to <http://www.azgu.gov/> login
9. After logging in, on the left hand side select "Search for a class or event"
10. Enter MAG 146 or MAG 362
11. Select the MAG course with the location at the District- Emerald Point ( multiple MAG course are offered year round)
12. Click Enroll
13. Click "yes enroll"
